THANKSGIVING OFFICE HOURS: The office will be closed on Thanksgiving, Thursday, November 24th and Friday, November 25th.

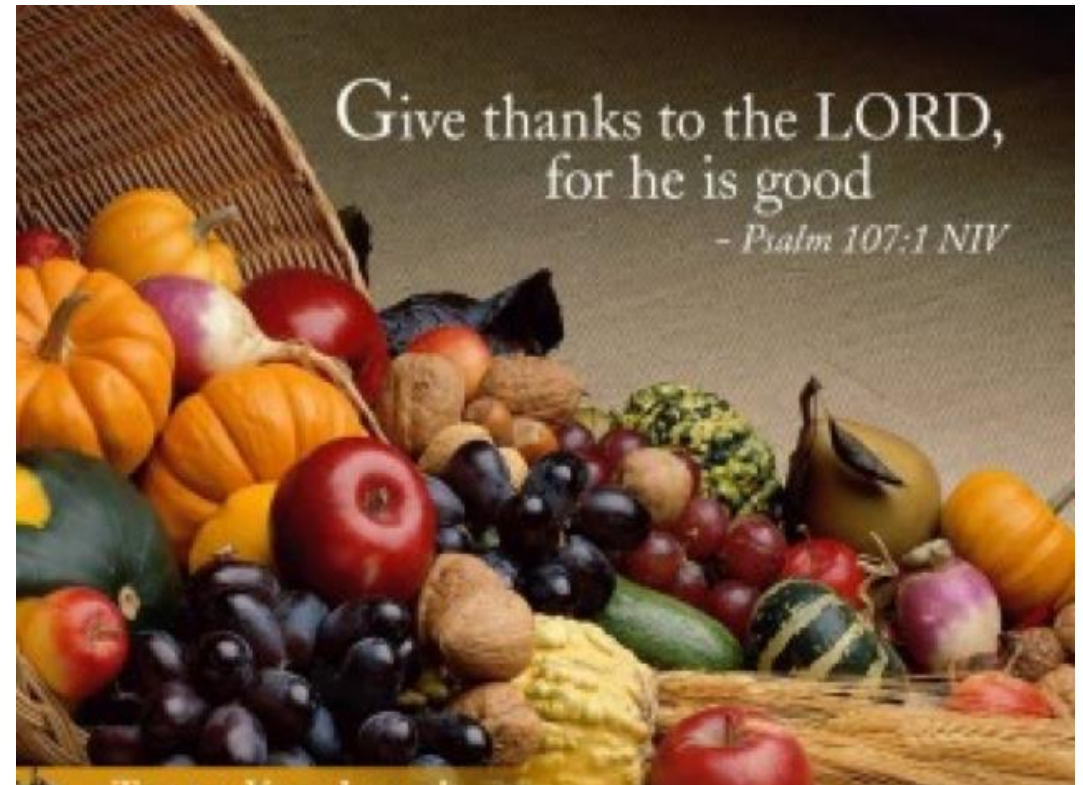
